# GCE O-Level Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) Mid-Year Examination 2023

# Achievements of our Students

## NIE Mathematics Challenge for Sec 1

This is an online Math quiz that is closely aligned to the current secondary Mathematics syllabus and the 5 distinction awardees are Adora Koh Yu Shaan (1 Resilience), Bryan Neo Yu Pin (1 Respect), Goh Kan Rui (1 Integrity), Lin Jianqi (1 Integrity) and Ye Peiwen (1 Care).

# Illustratum 2023

Illustratum 2023 competition organised by NUS Physics provides a platform for enthusiasts to present complex concepts in a way that captivates and engages. It also fosters curiosity, develops creative and critical thinking as well as a long-life passion for science exploration in students. It is the first time that Yishun Secondary School has participated in the competition and the YISHUN SEC TEAM 2 has clinched the Distinction Award. The members comprise three students from **3E2 - Mohammad Danish Aiman Bin Mohammad Rizal, Chai Chung You Jeremy and Chin Jun Hong Alfred.** The YISHUN SEC TEAM 1 from **3E1 - Loh Qian Ting, Jaydias Ng Ke Cheng and Vrion Chan** received the Certificate of Participation Award.

## **21st Elementz Science Project Competition**

This competition organised by Anderson Secondary School generates interest in scientific study through investigative-type projects in science and provides a platform for North Zone Primary and Lower Secondary school students to share their research findings. The project titled "Investigate Which Type of Starch Makes the Strongest Bioplastics" has received the Silver Award. The team of students who clinched the Silver Award are four students from 1 Care - Hipona Keziah Cody Daddy, Tong Li Xin Fiona, Sun Yuanzhi and Looi Yu Hao Nicas.

#### 8th Singapore Junior Biology Olympiad

The 8th Singapore Junior Biology Olympiad is jointly organized by the Singapore Institute of Biology and Science Centre Singapore to promote the advancement of Biology for Secondary School students and to encourage students to excel in Biology. The competition comprised a theory round for all students, followed by a practical round for the top seven schools. **Demerin Njay Gadon (4E1)** clinched the Silver Award, **Loh Tian Fa (4E1)** received the Bronze Award and **Y Kanthn (4E1)** received the Honorable Mention.

**NUS Geography Challenge** 

The NUS Geography Challenge seeks to ignite passion and inspire secondary school students to develop a keen interest in the dynamic discipline of Geography. Erwin Lim (4E1) received a Bronze award while his classmates Liu Yingxuan, Law Wei Tin and Max Low Yu Wen received Certificates of Participation.

Live On Festival Design Competition

Live On Festival (LOF) is an initiative started by the National Organ Transplant Unit (NOTU) from the Ministry of Health (MOH) to encourage participants, in particular youths, to express their thoughts on organ donation and transplantation through art and writing. It is designed to inculcate values of responsibility, compassion, empathy and altruism by providing insights into the delicate and emotive nature of the topic of organ donation and transplantation. **Erindianz Amellia Binte Suriyan (3E5)** received the Merit award and **Lin Xi (3E5)** received the Distinction award.

National Library Board Prove It! Contest

The National Library Board recently organised the Prove It! Contest, which challenges students in their knowledge and application of information literacy (IL) and critical thinking skills. The video entry from our school clinched a position in the Top 10 Gold (Video Category). The team comprises Lakshman s/o Nakkeeran (2 Resilience), Lor Jin Ting Avery (2 Integrity), Rathod Dhruv Dilipkumar (2 Resilience) and Muhammad Danial Haddy (2 Respect).

Ignite Skills Challenge 2023

This was organised by ITE where students had to participate in various challenges that are designed to emulate the courses offered at ITE. A total of 8 teams, comprising 17 students from 4NT, participated in 4 competition challenges, where they applied concepts they had learnt from English Language, Mathematics, Science, Retail Operations and Computer Applications. Out of the eight, one team emerged in the top 10 and went on to the Finals.

Nee Soon Central National Day Dinner
