GCE O-Level and N-Level Listening Comprehension and Oral Examinations

Unmasking Allowance for School-based and National Oral Examinations

Guidelines for the conduct of school-based oral examinations will be aligned to that of the national GCE oral examinations. This will enable the teachers to better assess the oral language competence of students. Oral examiners and candidates will be allowed to remove their face masks at the oral exam (for reading aloud/oral presentation and oral interaction) with mitigation measures in place. They should put on their face masks at other times, including silent preparation.

Secondary 4 E/NA and 5N Preliminary Examination

The preliminary examination for our graduating cohort will also be held in Term 3. The preliminary examination timetable will be posted on the school website for your reference at a later date.

Support for Our Graduating Students

In order to provide our graduating students with a conducive environment for self-study, we will be commencing Night Study from Tue, 12 Jul till Thu, 22 Sep. It will take place until 8:30 pm every Monday to Thursday.

Students are to report in school attire between 6:15 – 7:00 pm at the canteen for registration of attendance. They are to have their dinner before coming and must be committed to stay until the end of the session when they will be dismissed by the Teacher-in-charge.

GCE O-Level Mother Tongue Language (MTL) and Mother Tongue Language Syllabus B (MTLB) Listening Comprehension Examination

The above-mentioned examination will be held on **Tues, 5 Jul 2022**. Students who are not taking the examination will be dismissed at **12:30 pm** on that day. Please make the necessary transportation arrangements.
