NEW ACADEMIC YEAR 2022

GCE 'N' Level Examination Results 2021

We would like to congratulate our Secondary 4 Normal (Academic) and Normal (Technical) students on their sterling results this year.

76.9% of our 4 Normal (Academic) students are eligible for promotion to 5NA and 29% of our 4 Normal (Technical) students scored 2 distinctions or more.

Our "Most Improved Students" were selected based not just on improved academic results, but also on good and responsible behaviour in school as well as strong participation in Co-Curricular Activities through their years with us, as we believe in the holistic development of the child.

Reporting to School on 4 Jan 2022

Schools will re-open on Tue, 4 Jan for all students. Students are encouraged to take public transport to be environmentally friendly.

Parents/guardians of Secondary 1 students are allowed to drop off their child/ward in school. They are to leave the school immediately after doing so.

Morning Flag Raising Ceremony

Reporting time for Sec 1 & 2 students is 7:25am and Sec 3 & 4/5 students is 7:35am.

Flag-raising level assemblies (FRC) will start at 7:40 am daily with the following parameters:

a. A cap of around 300 persons from the same level per venue with 1m safe distancing between all individuals, and zoned by classes with 2m between classes;

- b. * All other levels, FRC will be held in your respective classrooms.
- c. FRC will not exceed 30 minutes and all individuals must be masked.

Safe Management Measures

The school continues to ensure safe management measures are in place to keep children safe. Do note the following:

- All students must wear face masks in school at all times. Masks worn to school should be plain with no graffiti designs on them. Students are advised to have an extra mask with them in case they need to change it in the course of the day, especially after PE lessons.
- Temperature-taking and additional visual and verbal screening continues daily for all students. All students must continue to bring their own oral-digital thermometers daily.
- Oral Digital Thermometers (ODTs) will be distributed free to the Secondary 1 students for their personal use. Students at the other levels who have lost or misplaced their ODTs, or have unserviceable ODTs, will have to purchase their own replacements. Students should have serviceable personal ODTs available for their use at all times of the year and not only for temperature-taking exercises.
- Students are required to carry their TraceTogether Tokens at all times. TT tokens can be collected from any Community Centre/Club. Singaporeans and Permanent Residents who are collecting their tokens for the first time can also request for the TT token to be delivered via post. Details can be found at token.gowhere.gov.sg
- Group work can be carried out during lessons and other activities. Group sizes will follow the prevailing national social group size of 5 pax.

Safety Measures during PE Lessons

PE lessons will resume according to current SMM in place. PE will comprise both individual and group activities where permissible.

While students will be required to wear their masks, they will be allowed to remove their masks when involved in strenuous activities.

The school will alter the PE lessons in accordance with any changes to the SMM.
