# Letter to Parents/Guardians – Term 1

*Welcome to 2022!* I hope this letter finds everyone well. In 2022, we look forward to developing your child/ward holistically by continuing to provide our students with engaging and enriching learning opportunities.

# Safe Management Measures (SMM)

The school continues with enforcing SMM for the term according to guidelines provided by MOE. Please refer to the SMM as stated in the previous correspondence dated 23 Dec 2020.

A gentle reminder that students who are unwell must see a doctor and stay at home. Students who have family members on HQO, SHN, LOA or MC (for flu-like symptoms) must not report to school and they must inform their form teachers of this.

All students must wear face masks in school at all times. Masks worn to school should be plain with no graffiti designs on them. Students are advised to have an extra mask with them in case they need to change it in the course of the day, especially after PE lessons.

Temperature-taking and additional visual and verbal screening continues daily for all students. All students must continue to bring their own oral-digital thermometers daily.

Students are required to carry their TraceTogether Tokens at all times. TT tokens can be collected from any Community Centre/Club. Singaporeans and Permanent Residents who are collecting their tokens for the first time can also request for the TT token to be delivered via post. Details can be found at token.gowhere.gov.sg

Group work can be carried out during lessons and other activities. Group sizes will follow the prevailing national social group size of 5 pax.

# GCE O-Level Examination 2021 Results

The GCE O-Level Examination results were released on 12 Jan 2022. The class of 2021 performed well in the GCE O-Level Examination 2021.

The Mean Subject Grade (MSG) improved from 22.4 (2021) to 20.6 (2022). The expected MSG for the cohort was 22.3.

The percentage of students who are eligible for Junior College has also increased from 39% in 2021 to 54% in 2022. The percentage of students who qualified to move on to the polytechnic has also increased from 93.2% to 94.5%.

Heartiest congratulations to the class of 2021 and the teachers who have journeyed with them.

## Attendance in School

Consistent attendance in school is critical in order for your child/ward to benefit fully from the learning experiences. A medical certificate will be required if your child/ward is absent from school, tests and examinations. Do note that parents' letters are not accepted unless under exceptional cases.

## **Co–Curricular Activities (CCA)**

CCA is critical in the holistic development of your child/ward. It is essential for each student to be part of a CCA and attend all training sessions.

All CCAs have commenced with face-to-face sessions in Term 1 Week 1 of 2022 with all the necessary safe management measures enforced.

## Secondary One CCA Experience Programme

In order to help our Secondary One students make an informed choice of CCA, the school has arranged for a CCA Experience Programme for them.

The CCA Experience Programme will take place between Term 1 Week 1 to Term 1 Week 6. This programme provides your child/ward an opportunity to experience the different CCAs before making his/her final choice.

The school is organising a CCA Engagement session for parents/guardian on Fri, 14 Jan 2022 from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm. During this session there will be a briefing by HOD/PE & CCA on matters regarding CCA and this will be followed by a Q & A session where you can clarify any doubts that you might have. ## National Digital Literacy Programme (NDLP)

At MOE's Committee of Supply Debate in March 2020, MOE launched the National Digital Literacy Programme (NDLP) for our schools and Institutes of Higher Education. The NDLP was launched to make digital learning inclusive by equipping students with the digital literacies to be future-ready. Through the NDLP, all secondary school students will own a school-prescribed Personal Learning Device (PLD) by end 2021. The device will be used to facilitate an environment that encourages personalised learning.

Our Secondary 2 to 4 students have received their PLD in 2021. If your child/ward has not purchase his/her PLD, do contact the school to process his/her purchase.

#### Weighted Assessment (WA)

All WA will be scheduled on Tuesdays from 7:50 am to 8:50 am from Term 1, Week 3. Please refer to the school website for the WA schedule.

A student who is absent for WA or examination due to illness must produce a medical certificate from a certified doctor upon return to school. The medical report/statement must clearly state the doctor's diagnosis and certification that the student is unfit to take the test.

Medical certificates without the doctor's diagnosis is considered not valid. Students who do not produce any medical certificate will be given zero mark for the paper they have missed. Medical certificates issued by Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) practitioners and letters from parents will not be accepted as valid reasons.
