Letter to Parents/Guardians - Term 2

Speech Day

This year's Speech Day festivities will take place on Fri, 10 Mar 23, from 6:45pm to 9pm. One of the highlights this year is the Caring Hearts Carnival, proudly put together by our students, which will provide an afternoon of fun and games for invited senior citizens from eldercare centres.

This will be followed by the Parade and Prize Presentation, which is taking place in the evening to allow parents/guardians to join us in celebrating their child's/ward's achievements.

Academic Competitions

Our students have performed well in academic-related external competitions.

Mathematics

Yishunites took part in the Singapore and Asian School Mathematics Olympiad (SASMO) 2022 and were awarded 1 Silver and 6 Bronze awards, and received 3 Honorable Mentions.

Our students from the Normal Course students took part in the All Singapore Secondary Mathematics Competition for Normal Course 2022. Our Secondary One students from the Normal Academic and Technical Course won the Top 5 positions in the Individual Category and in the Team Category.

Humanities

Our Secondary Two students took part in the NLB-CPDD Historical Scene Investigation; a competition organised by the National Library Board, and they clinched the Gold Award in the competition.

Science

Our student-representatives who took part in the 11th International Biomedical Quiz organised by the Anglo-Chinese Junior College (ACJC) Science and Mathematics Council emerged victorious; clinching the Individual Silver Award for their stellar performance.

These competitions are our conscious efforts to provide our students with a platform to showcase their knowledge and skills. These awards show our students' ability to apply their learning beyond the classroom.
