### Letter to Parents/Guardians - End of Term 2

Greetings to all parents and guardians!

We are fast approaching the end of Term 2 and I would like to thank everyone for working closely with the school. ### **Travel Declaration**

All parents/guardian are required to make a travel declaration if your child/ward intends to travel during the June holidays.

Please declare your child/ward's travel plans on Parents Gateway by Fri, 30 May 2025 only if your child/ward intends to travel during the holidays on Parents Gateway.

If there is a change of travel plan(s) after declaration, please submit a new travel declaration for the updated travel destination via PG or inform the school for cancellation of travel plan(s).

### **Student Matters**

Home-based Learning (HBL) in Term 3 and National Oral Examinations for English Language (EL) and Mother Tongue Languages (MTL).

Since 2024, all EL and MTL oral examinations have been streamlined and held during a specified number of full-days and half-days in Term 3. The dates for the EL and MTL oral examinations are as follows:

- Mon, 14 Jul (PM)
- Tue to Thu, 15 to 17 Jul (AM and PM)
- Fri, 18 Jul (PM)

Specific dates for your child/ward's EL and MTL Oral Examination can be found on the examination entry proof. Please refer to the entry proof to ensure that your child/ward is aware of the dates and times of the respective examinations.

Candidates will be briefed on the reporting times and other administrative information by the Supervising Oral Examiner in Term 3.

To facilitate the smooth running of the streamlined oral examination, HBL in Term 3 will take place from 15 to 17 Jul 2025. Your child/ward will be informed on the details by their subject teachers accordingly.

#### STEM Playground 2025 Challenge #1

Our lower secondary students took part in the STEM Playground 2025 Challenge #1. The competition was jointly organised by the Science Centre Singapore, the James Dyson Foundation, and MOE Curriculum Planning and Development Division.

Demonstrating creativity, scientific understanding, and teamwork, our students engineered an innovative and functional boat that impressed the judges. Competing against 121 primary and secondary schools across the nation, our students' hard work and ingenuity paid off as they secured the 3rd place in the secondary school category.

This achievement highlights our students' growing passion for STEM and their potential to excel in future scientific endeavours.

### **SASMO 2025**

Our students took part in the Singapore and Asian School Mathematics Olympiad (SASMO) 2025, a Mathematics competition with a high focus on non-routine problem sums which develops students' interest in mathematical problem solving which involves reasoning, logical, creative and critical thinking.
