### **Letter to Parents/Guardian – Term 3**

### **Student Matters**

#### **Home-based Learning (HBL) in Term 3 and National Oral Examinations for English Language (EL) and Mother Tongue Languages (MTL).**

EL and MTL oral examinations have been streamlined and held during a specified number of full-days and half-days in Term 3. The dates for the EL and MTL oral examinations are as follows:

- Mon, 13 Jul (PM)
- Tue to Thu, 14 to 16 Jul (AM and PM)
- Fri, 17 Jul (PM)

Specific dates for your child/ward's EL and MTL Oral Examination can be found on the examination entry proof. Please refer to the entry proof to ensure that your child/ward is aware of the dates and reporting times of the respective examinations.

Candidates have been briefed on the reporting times and other administrative information by the Supervising Oral Examiner.

To facilitate the smooth running of the streamlined oral examination, HBL in Term 3 will take place from 14 to 16 Jul 2026. Your child/ward will be informed on the details by their subject teachers accordingly.

#### **GCE O-Level Mother Tongue Language Listening Comprehension**

The above-mentioned examination would be held on Tue, 7 Jul 2026. Students who are not taking the examination will be dismissed at 12:30 pm. They are expected to leave the school premises immediately after dismissal. There will be no CCA and after-school programmes on that day as well

#### **Sale of Bottled and Canned Drinks in the Canteen**

Since the implementation of Singapore's Beverage Container Return Scheme (BCRS), an additional \$0.10 is charged for all bottled and canned beverages sold. To ensure cost effectiveness for our students, bottled and canned drinks will no longer be sold at the school canteen with effect from 29 June 2026.

Other beverages and freshly prepared drinks will still be available and sold in packets and cups as usual. Students are highly encouraged to bring their own water bottles and make use of the water coolers located around the school for refills.
