



- Students applying for JC will need only 5 G3 subjects instead of 6 G3 subjects to compute their L1R4 score \*Latest\*
- Students applying to Polytechnic Year 1 can use a G2 subject to compute their ELR2B2 score for one [Best] subject
- PFP will be open to students taking all G3 subjects, or a mix of G3 & G2 subjects
- Students who meet the academic requirements during their Year 1 Semester 1 examinations in ITE may be offered the option for inflight acceleration, which allows direct progression directly to Year 2 in the following semester.

- The computation of the L1R4 aggregate continues to require three subjects from both the Mathematics/Science and Humanities subject groups.
- Millennia Institute (MI)'s L1R4 subject requirements will also be updated to require these three subjects, while the qualifying threshold will remain at L1R4 ≤20.

**Additional 2 bonus points** are still awarded if a student has applied and is selected for the Chinese, Malay, or Tamil Language Elective Programme.

### **Bonus Point System**

- The cap on bonus points for JC admission will be lowered from a maximum of 4 to 3 points to account for the reduction in the number of subjects included in the L1R4 aggregate computation.
- The bonus points cap for admission to MI will also be aligned with that for JC admissions.

Cut-off score will be adjusted from 26 to 22 points, since the last 'B' subject will be mapped from G3 to G2.

Remaining four subjects must continue to be taken at G3 to ensure that students can cope with the academic rigour in polytechnics.
