General Information

Passport & Visa

A valid international passport is required for all travellers entering Hong Kong and Shenzhen. The passport must have at least 6 months validity from the date of return to Singapore.

Pre-arrival registration is required for Indian nationals to Hong Kong.

Visa is required for Indians and Filipinos entering Shenzhen.

Climate

Temperatures are expected to be between 18 - 28°C. Sunrise is at ~6.33am and sunset at ~5.40pm.

Time

There is no time difference between Hong Kong, Shenzhen and Singapore (GMT +8).

Water

Tap water in Hong Kong and Shenzhen is <u>non-potable</u>, but safe for washing and brushing your teeth. Bottled water (2 x 500ml per pax) will also be provided daily.

Electricity


Hong Kong runs on the same electrical outlet as Singapore. No adaptor is required. However, you will need a universal travel adaptor in Shenzhen.

There are three types of plugs used in China:

Type A (two flat pins)

Type C (two narrow round pins)

Type I (three-pronged angled pins).



It is also helpful to bring a multi-way plug for charging multiple devices.

Staying Connected

China's extensive internet censorship system restricts access to foreign platforms that do not comply with their government regulations. Popular apps that are blocked include Google services (like Gmail and YouTube), Facebook, Instagram, WhatsApp, and Telegram.

Connecting to the local WiFi (e.g. Hotel) will restrict accessibility to these blocked websites/apps. As such, it is highly recommended to pre-purchase a travel eSIM which specifies mobile data compatibility with your required apps or ensure your existing mobile plan has international roaming.

China eSIM or physical SIM cards require a virtual private network (VPN) to overwrite the "Great Firewall of China" and access the usual features. However, VPNs can be unstable (especially the free or cheaper ones) and are thus not recommended.

Currency

Hong Kong dollar: HKD 6 ≈ SGD 1

Chinese Yuan (CNY) / Renminbi (RMB): ¥5.5 ≈ SGD 1 Please change your currency in Singapore before your trip.

Mobile Payments

Cash is still accepted in most places in China, but many shops and restaurants prefer mobile payments over cash.

The most dominant payment methods in China are <u>Alipay</u> and <u>WeChat Pay</u>. Download the app and register (before your trip), then link an international bank card (Visa / Mastercard) to your account. *Note: Foreign users incur a 3% transaction fee for amounts over RMB 200*.

Snacks & Drinks: ~ HKD / CNY / RMB 30 – 50 per day (optional) Souvenirs / Gifts: ~ HKD / CNY / RMB 300 – 500 (optional)

REMEMBER:

Packing Checklist

One piece check-in luggage ≤25kg and one hand-carry bag ≤7kg

*Liquids, aerosols, gels (LAGs) and other items of similar consistency in hand-carried luggage must be in containers with capacity no greater than 100ml/g each. All containers must fit in a transparent re-sealable plastic bag and not exceed 1L in total. LAGs that do not meet the guidelines must be checked-in.

TOILETRIES	 □ Comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, contact lens, solution, case, shaver, sanitary pads □ Extra pair of glasses / contact lenses □ Shower gel, shampoo, conditioner, facial wash □ Other personal toiletries (e.g. deodorant, sun block, lip balm, moisturizer, nail clipper) □ Hand sanitizer, tissue packs, wet wipes □ Plastic / zip lock bags for dirty clothing
OTHERS	□ Backpack / Crossbody bag − as hand-carry bag for daily use □ Your passport and necessary travel documents (e.g. visa if required) □ HKD & CNY/RMB cash or be Alipay / WeChat Pay ready □ Water bottle − emptied, to refill for flight prior boarding □ Reusable bag − most shops charge for bags □ Foldable umbrella / raincoat / poncho □ Mobile phone & charger □ Universal travel adaptor and multi-way plug □ Writing material (blue/black ink pen) □ Personal medication with proper labels: e.g. for headache, fever, flu, sore throat, diarrhoea, motion sickness, asthma inhaler, etc. □ Vitamin C □ Thermometer and disposable masks (at least 10) □ Souvenir for Hong Kong school exchange (provided by school)
